Subject: Local Plan : response to main modifications

Dear Mr Moore,

When we last met, there was discussion around the Brickfields site in Bridge.

As Bridge Parish Chairman, I argued that the Brickfields site was not justified, because whilst the Local Plan had allocated a number of dwellings within Bridge, there was a Neighbourhood Plan being developed which had allocated that same number of dwellings elsewhere and which is expected to bring additional benefits to the Parish and thereby to the District. Hence, I argued in support of Bridge's emerging Neighbourhood Plan, and set out reasons why the District's proposals for a Brickfields development was not justified.

The Bridge Neighbourhood Plan has allocated a site, one which is just within, but at the edge of, the proposed green gap between Bridge and the City.

I would be grateful therefore, if you would consider a slight amendment, which has been discussed with Ms Britton, as per the attached map removing the shaded area from the proposed green gap, and so retaining the option for a development of thirty dwellings, a development which currently appears within the emerging Bridge Neighbourhood Plan.
